

This report is based on information from graduates and employment resources received within six months of graduation 84.5 percent of the 807 members of the Class of 2016 (or 682 graduates).

Of those who responded:

- > 96 percent of the Class of 2016 has secured full-time professional employment, admission to graduate degree programs, or participation in volunteer service programs.
- > The average salary for the Class of 2016 is \$53,910 (excluding bonuses). This reflects a slight increase in salary from the Class of 2015 average which was \$50,098.
- > The percentage of graduates obtaining employment through senior year campus recruiting and employment resources is 44.2 percent.
- > Financial Services was the highest area of placement consisting of 21.0 percent.
